A. Docket Nos. BPU GR21050860 and OAL PUC 09921-21 – In the Matter of the Petition of New Jersey Natural Gas Company for the Annual Review and Revision of its Basic Gas Supply Service (BGSS) and Conservation Incentive Program (CIP) Rates for F/Y 2022.

The Board will consider finalizing New Jersey Natural Gas Company's 2021 Basic Gas Supply Service and Conservation Incentive Program filing. The parties have executed a stipulation, which if approved by the Board, will result in no impact to customer bills.

B. Docket Nos. ER21111209 and GR21111210 – In the Matter of the Petition of Public Service Electric and Gas Company for Approval of Electric and Gas Rate Adjustments Pursuant to the Energy Strong II Program; and

Docket Nos. EO18060629 and GO18060630 – In the Matter of the Petition of Public Service Electric and Gas Company for Approval of the Second Energy Strong Program (Energy Strong II).

The Board will consider Public Service Electric and Gas Company's November 2021 Energy Strong II rate roll in. The parties have executed a stipulation, which if approved by the Board, will result in an annual increase of \$7.40 for a typical residential electric customer using 6,920 kWh annually and an annual increase of \$0.46 for a typical residential gas customer using 1,040 therms annually.
