






**BEFORE KIMBERLY A. MOSS, ALJ:**

On July 2, 2012, this matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for hearing as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to-15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F 1 to- 13. A telephone prehearing was scheduled and conducted on July 23, 2012 during which time a follow-up telephone status conference was agreed to be held on August 9, 2012. During the pendency of the status conference the parties agreed on a hearing date of November 15, 2012. Prior to the hearing respondent advised that the parties have reached a settlement and there was no need for a hearing. On November

15, 2012 the undersigned received a copy of the signed Stipulation of Settlement, which is incorporated herein by reference.

I have reviewed the record and terms of the Stipulation of Settlement and **FIND:**


1. The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by the signatures of the parties or their representatives.
2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with law.

I **CONCLUDE** that the agreement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1 and therefore, it is **ORDERED** that the parties comply with the settlement terms and that these proceedings be and are hereby concluded.

I hereby **FILE** my initial decision with the **BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES** for consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the **BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES**, which by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter. If the Board of Public Utilities does not adopt, modify or reject this decision within forty-five (45) days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10.

STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT
