BY THE BOARD:

On October 8, 2015, Joseph M. Dolan ("Petitioner") filed a petition with the Board of Public Utilities ("Board") related to a billing dispute with Atlantic City Electric, Co. ("ACE" or "Respondent") for electric services rendered by Respondent to the Petitioners' Harrisburg Avenue premises in Atlantic City, New Jersey ("account").

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") W. Todd Miller.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and voluntarily agreed to resolve the matter and entered into a signed Stipulation of Settlement ("Stipulation") that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision issued on March 4, 2016, and submitted to the Board on March 9, 2016, to which the Stipulation was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Miller found that the Stipulation was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

Pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation and in order to fully resolve this matter, the parties agreed to an outstanding balance of \$20,000.00 on the account ending in 9987. Petitioner has agreed to submit ninety-nine (99) monthly payments of \$202.02 without interest, to clear the remaining balance due on the account and to maintain current payments for all future monthly

electric usage charges, beginning with the April 2016 bill. Should Petitioner fail to comply with the terms of the Stipulation, Respondent may take such action against Petitioner as permitted by law, regulation, or tariff.

After review of the Initial Decision and the Stipulation, the Board <u>HEREBY FINDS</u> that the parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures and that, by the terms of the Stipulation, they have fully resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter. Accordingly, the Board <u>HEREBY ADOPTS</u> the Initial Decision and the Stipulation executed by the parties in their entirety. The Stipulation is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The effective date of this Order is May 7, 2016.
