#### BY THE BOARD:

On October 6, 2023, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:9-7.1 to 7.7, Gordon's Corner Water Company. ("GCWC" or "Company") filed a petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board" or "BPU") seeking to modify its Purchased Water Adjustment Clause ("PWAC") rates for calendar year 2024 ("Petition"). By this Decision and Order, the Board considers a stipulation of settlement ("Stipulation") executed by Board Staff ("Staff"), the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel ("Rate Counsel"), and CGWC (collectively, "Parties") intended to resolve all issues related to the Petition.

#### BACKGROUND/PROCEDURAL HISTORY

GCWC is a water public utility engaged in the business of collecting, treating, and distributing water for retail service to approximately 14,600 customers in portions of the Townships of Marlboro and Manalapan in Monmouth County, New Jersey. The Company's principal office is located at 27 Vanderburg Road, Marlboro, New Jersey, 07746.

The Company purchases water on a routine basis, pursuant to purchased water agreements, from: 1) the Township of Marlboro; 2) United Water Matchaponix; and 3) the Township of Aberdeen. The Company obtains a substantial portion of the water necessary to meet its overall water supply requirements through purchased water contracts with the Township of Marlboro and SUEZ-Matchaponix Water Company.<sup>1</sup>

By Order dated December 21, 2022, the Board approved GCWC's current PWAC tariff, setting a PWAC rate of \$0.08 per thousand gallons of water for general service customers.<sup>2</sup>

#### **Petition**

By the Petition, based on information available at the time of filing, the Company noted that it anticipates its purchased water contract rates to increase based on: 1) Middlesex Water Company's ("MWC") currently pending base rate case; and 2) Veolia's base rate case which GCWC expected to be filed imminently.<sup>3</sup>

By the Petition, GCWC indicated that Marlboro obtains a portion of its water supply from MWC the cost of which will increase as a result of MWC's pending base rate case. Based on the data contained in MWC's base rate filing, if MWC receives its fully requested rate increase, GCWC's Marlboro purchased water rate would increase from \$5.62167 per thousand gallons to \$7.325 per thousand gallons.

GCWC further indicated that any increase resulting from Veolia's anticipated base rate case will further increase the Company's purchased water costs.

By the Petition, GCWC included a true-up schedule reconciling actual and estimated purchased water revenues and costs for the period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023. Based on the Company's schedules, GCWC estimated that there may be an under-recovery in the amount of \$960. However, GCWC indicated it does not seek to carry forward any over- or under-recovery balance in the prospective PWAC rate for 2024. However, the Company indicated it intends to continue to update its over- and under-recovery calculations throughout the pendency of this proceeding to allow the prospective PWAC to properly continue its true-up function.

A Board-appointed Regulatory Officer presided over public hearings on January 29, 2024, at 4:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. No members of the public attended the hearings and the Board received no written comments on this matter.

#### **STIPULATION**

1. The Parties agree to an overall stipulated increase of \$198,750 or 1.4% of the Company's overall revenues of \$14,003,593.

- 2. The Parties recommend that the Board approve an increase to the Company's PWAC rate upon PWAC Rate Schedule No. 1A from \$0.08 to \$0.14 per thousand gallons of water for general service customers, effective March 1, 2024.
- 3. The effective PWAC rate adjustment results in an increase in the monthly bill of a residential customer with a 5/8" meter, using 7,000 gallons of water per month, from \$63.46 to \$63.88 an increase of \$0.42 per month, or 0.7%. Attached to the Stipulation as Exhibit A is a Schedule reflecting GCWC's new purchased water costs effective March 1, 2024.
- 4. The proposed PWAC rate of \$0.14 per thousand gallons of water is calculated as being effective March 1, 2024 as indicated in Exhibit B to the Stipulation.
- 5. The PWAC rate established herein will increase annual revenues by \$198,750, or 1.4%, as reflected in Exhibit B to the Stipulation.
- 6. Attached to the Stipulation as Exhibit C is PWAC Rate Schedule No. 1A, a tariff sheet reflecting the new PWAC rate. The new PWAC rate conforms to the Stipulation and is designed to produce the revenues to which the parties have stipulated.
- 7. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 14:9-7.4, the Company shall file with the Board, not later than 45 days after the end of the PWAC year, PWAC true-up schedules in connection with this proceeding. The Company's PWAC year resulting from this matter ends on February 28, 2025. Copies of the true-up schedules will be served upon Staff and Rate Counsel.

#### **DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS**

Having reviewed the record in this matter, including the Petition and the Stipulation, the Board <a href="HEREBY FINDS">HEREBY FINDS</a> that the Parties have voluntarily agreed to the Stipulation, and that the Stipulation fully disposes of all issues in this proceeding and is consistent with the law. The Board <a href="FURTHER FINDS">FURTHER FINDS</a> the Stipulation to be reasonable and in the public interest in accordance with the law. As such, the Board <a href="HEREBY ADOPTS">HEREBY ADOPTS</a> the Stipulation attached hereto, including all attachments and schedules, as its own, incorporating by reference the terms and conditions of the Stipulation as if fully set forth at length herein.

As a result of the Stipulation, the average residential customer paying a fixed charge, will experience an increase in their monthly bill from \$63.46 to approximately \$63.88, an increase of \$0.42, or approximately 0.7%.

The Board <u>HEREBY</u> <u>DIRECTS</u> the Company to file tariff pages conforming to the terms and conditions of the Stipulation and this Order by March 1, 2024.

The effective date of this Order is February 21, 2024, with rates to become effective on and after March 1, 2024.

#### TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES:

Petitioner, Gordon's Corner Water Company ("Petitioner" or "Company"), is a public utility of the State of New Jersey, subject to the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") and franchised to provide water service in the Townships of Marlboro and Manalapan, Monmouth County, New Jersey. On October 6, 2023, Petitioner filed a petition with the Board, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:9-7.1 et seq., for approval to change the levels of its purchased water adjustment clause ("PWAC") ("Petition").

Petitioner purchases water on a routine basis from two (2) separate entities, each of which adjusts its rates for water service pursuant to contract: the Marlboro Township Water Utility Division and Veolia Water New Jersey, Inc., all pursuant to water purchase agreements. By the Petition, Petitioner proposed to increase its PWAC rate from \$0.08 to \$0.84 per thousand gallons of water.

Virtual public hearings were held on January 29, 2024 at 4:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m., following publication of an appropriate public notice. No members of the public appeared or provided comments at the virtual public hearing.

Throughout the course of this proceeding, Petitioner was served with, and responded in full to, discovery requests propounded by the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel ("Rate Counsel") and Board Staff ("Staff"). Petitioner, Rate Counsel, and Board Staff also conferred on a number of occasions regarding this matter. Following a review of the Petition, conducting discovery, and discussions among the parties, the Company, Rate Counsel, Staff (collectively, "Parties") have reached an agreement on this matter, the provisions of which are set forth below. have agreed to a total overall stipulated increase of \$198,750 or 1.4% of Company revenues of \$14,003,593. As a result of an analysis of the Petition and Exhibits, Petitioner's responses to discovery, as well as the Parties' discussions and negotiations in this matter, the Signatory Parties have reached an agreement, the provisions of which are set forth below.

## SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

- 1. The Parties agree to an overall stipulated increase of \$198,750 or 1.4% of the Company's overall revenues of \$14,003,593.
- 2. The Parties recommend that the Board approve an increase to Petitioner's PWAC rate upon PWAC Rate Schedule No. 1A from \$0.08 to \$0.14 per thousand gallons of water for general service customers, effective March 1, 2024.
- 3. The effective PWAC rate adjustment results in an increase in the monthly bill of a residential customer with a 5/8" meter, using 7,000 gallons of water per month, from \$63.46 to

\$63.88 an increase of \$0.42 per month, or 0.7%. Attached hereto as **Exhibit A** is a Schedule reflecting Petitioner's new purchased water costs effective March 1, 2024.

- 4. The proposed PWAC rate of \$0.14 per thousand gallons of water is calculated as being effective March 1, 2024 as indicated in Exhibit B.
- 5. The PWAC rate established herein will increase annual revenues by \$198,750, or 1.4%, as reflected in **Exhibit B**.
- 6. Attached hereto as **Exhibit C** is PWAC Rate Schedule No. 1A, a tariff sheet reflecting the new PWAC rate. The new PWAC rate conforms to this Stipulation and is designed to produce the revenues to which the parties have stipulated herein.
- 7. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 14:9-7.4, the Petitioner shall file with the Board, not later than 45 days after the end of the PWAC year, PWAC true-up schedules in connection with this proceeding. The Company's PWAC year resulting from this matter ends on February 28, 2025. Copies of the true-up schedules will be served upon Staff and Rate Counsel.
- 8. This Stipulation shall be binding on the Parties to this proceeding upon approval by the Board. This Stipulation shall bind the Parties in this matter only and shall not be considered precedential in any other proceeding involving the Parties hereto.
- 9. This Stipulation contains terms, each of which is interdependent with the others and essential in its own right to the signing of this Stipulation. Each term is vital to the agreement as a whole, since the Parties individually and jointly state that they would not have signed the Stipulation had any term been modified in any way. In the event that any modification whatsoever is made to this Stipulation, each of the Parties hereto is entitled to certain procedures in the event of such occurrence.

10. If any modification is made to the terms of this Stipulation, the Parties must be given the right to be placed in the position in which each Party was before this Stipulation was executed. It is essential that each Party be given the option to modify its own position, to accept the proposed change(s), or to resume the proceeding as if no agreement had been reached.

11. The Parties believe that these procedures are fair to all concerned and, therefore, they are made an integral and essential element of this Stipulation.

12. This Stipulation may be executed in as many counterparts as there are signatories to this Stipulation, each of which counterpart shall be an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.
