GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Under the direction of a Supervising Engineer or Bureau Chief of Engineering Services, monitors Utilities' compliance with applicable regulatory codes including reliability standards and programs; assists with the review and analysis of petitions before the Board, provides general support for the division and Bureau and implements the directives of the Board as required. May also be required to participate in PJM meetings on matters of interest to the Board.

Work Responsibilities:

- Monitor Electric Distribution Company compliance with applicable regulatory codes.
- Conduct review of applications and petitions before the Board on all electrical matters affecting NJ.
- Support Board policy on FERC, NERC and PJM matters that affect NJ constituents.
- Investigate and resolve customer technical issues and complaints.

- Support rule and legislation changes as required.

REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in engineering.

NOTE: Possession of a valid Professional Engineer's license issued by the New Jersey Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors may be substituted for the Bachelor's degree in engineering.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in the field of public utility operations or regulations including the conduct of engineering studies relating to utility valuation, rate or service determination.

Experience in the electric distribution or transmission fields (design, operation, construction or regulatory) and familiarly with PJM and Bulk Transmission operation preferred. Understanding of the roles of FERC, NERC, PJM operations and IEEE guidelines and NESC codes.
