New Jersey Clean Energy Program Fiscal Year 2021 Protocols to Measure Resource Savings

Docket No. QO20090584

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“NJBPU” or “Board”) hereby gives notice of a request for stakeholder comments on the *New Jersey’s Clean Energy Program*TM (“NJCEP”) draft Fiscal Year 2021 (“FY21”) Protocols to Measure Resource Savings (“Protocols”).

The protocols estimate energy and resource savings for technologies and measures that NJCEP supports. NJBPU occasionally updates these protocols to reflect the addition of new programs, modifications to existing programs, and the results of program evaluations. The protocols are intended to be used consistently statewide to assess program impacts and calculate energy and resource savings to:

1. Provide inputs for planning and cost-effectiveness calculations;
2. Report to the Board on program performance;
3. Provide information to regulators and program administrators for determining eligibility for administrative performance incentives (to the extent that NJBPU has approved such incentives); and
4. Assess the environmental benefits of program implementation.



Written comments may be submitted electronically to board.secretary@bpu.nj.gov in PDF or Word format with the subject “FY21 Protocols.” Commenters may also file comments electronically through the Board’s External Access Portal upon obtaining a MyNewJersey Portal ID. Once you establish a MyNewJersey account, you’ll need an authorization code, which you can request by emailing NJBPU’s IT Helpdesk at BPUITHELPDESK@bpu.nj.gov.
