Rule Adoption with Substantial Changes – Comment Period

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“NJBP” or “Board”) has authorized, at its October 14 Agenda meeting, the proposal of rule amendments with substantial changes for publication in the New Jersey Register for public comment.

Following the previously-held stakeholder process and Staff’s review of the comments received regarding proposed rule amendments to N.J.A.C. 14:4 et seq., concerning energy competition and specifically to subchapter 5, N.J.A.C. 14:4-5 et seq., Energy Licensing and Registration Staff has removed part of the previously-proposed additions in N.J.A.C. 14:4-1.2 and -5.1 for further discussion and analysis. The items removed include the “Self-supply gas end user customers” and “Self-supply load serving entity end user customers” additions, as well as, the inclusion of customer count and market share to N.J.A.C. 14:4-5.1(k). 
The deadline for public comments on the re-proposal will be set by the Office of Administrative Law. Comments on these matters should be sent to Board.Secretary@bpu.nj.gov, Rules.Comments@bpu.nj.gov, and Tps.Pricelink@bpu.nj.gov.

Commenters are encouraged to file their submissions electronically through the Board’s External Access Portal after obtaining a MyNewJersey Portal ID.
