## **Background**

On January 31, 2018, Governor Phil Murphy signed EO8 setting a goal of 3,500 megawatts (“MW”) of OSW by 2030, and calling upon NJBPU to fully implement OWEDA and initiate an Offshore Wind Strategic Planning Process.

By Board Order dated February 28, 2018, the Board directed NJBPU Staff to take specific actions to implement EO8, including to develop an OSWSP in collaboration with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and other New Jersey state agencies with responsibilities arising under OWEDA. On September 5, 2018 a purchase order was issued to Ramboll US Corporation (“Ramboll”) to develop the OSWSP. Work on the OSWSP commenced in September 2018.

On November 19, 2019, Governor Murphy signed EO92, increasing the state’s OSW goal to 7,500 MW by 2035. As a result of the change in OSW goals, NJBPU Staff directed Ramboll to revise the OSWSP to reflect the new 7,500 MW goal.
